Spiritual Gifts

Administration: the gift that enables a believer to formulate, direct and carry out plans necessary to fulfill a purpose. 1 Cor 12:28; Acts 14:23

Artistry: the gift that gives the believer the skill of creating artistic expressions that produce a spiritual response of strength and inspiration. Ex 31: 1-11; Ps 149: 3a

Discernment: the gift that motivates a believer to seek God's will and purpose and apply that understanding to individual and parish situations.
Jn 16:6-15; Rom 9:1; 1 Cor 2:9-16

Evangelism: the gift that moves believers to reach non-believers in such a way that they are baptized and become active members of the Christian community.
Mt 28: 16-20; Eph 4:11-16; Acts 2: 36-40

Exhortation: the gift that moves the believer to reach out with Christian love and presence to people in personal conflict facing a spiritual void.
Jn 14:1; 2 Tim 1: 16-18; 2 Jn 5-8

Faith: the gift that gives a believer the eyes to see the Spirit at work and the ability to trust the Spirit's leading without indication of where it all might lead.
Gen 12: 1-4a; Mk 5: 25-34; 1 Thes 1: 8-10

Giving: the gift that enables a believer to recognize God's blessings and to respond to those blessings by generously and sacrificially giving of one's resources (time, talent, and treasure) 2 Cor 9:6-15; Lk 21: 1-4

Hospitality: The gift that causes a believer to joyfully welcome and receive guests and those in need of food and lodging. Rom 12:13; Rom 16: 23; Lk 10:38

Intercession: the gift that enables a believer to pray with certainty that prayer is heard and when requests are made, answers will come.
Mt 6:6-15; Lk 11:1-10; Eph 6:18

Knowledge: the gift that drives a person to learn, analyze and uncover new insights with regard to the Bible and faith. 1 Cor 12:8; 1 Cor 14:6; Rom 12:2

Leadership: the gift that gives a believer the confidence to step forward, give direction and provide motivation to fulfill a dream or complete a task.
Rom 12:8; Jn 21: 15-17; 2 Tim 4: 1-5

Mercy: the gift that motivates a believer to feel deeply for those in physical, spiritual, or emotional need and then act to meet that need. Lk 7: 12-15; Lk 10: 30-37; Mt 25: 34-36

Music: the gift that inspires a believer to present personal witness and inspiration to other through singing or through playing a musical instrument.
Ps 96:1-9; Ps 100: 1-2; Ps 149: 1-2; Ps 33: 1-5; Ps 150; 1 Sam 16: 14-23

Pastoring: (shepherding): the gift that gives a believer the confidence, capability, and compassion to provide spiritual leadership and direction for individuals or groups of believers. 1 Tim 4: 12-16; 1 Tim 3: 1-13; 2 Tim: 4: 1-2

Service (helps): the gift that enables a believer to work gladly behind the scenes in order that God's work is fulfilled. Lk 23: 50-54; Rom 16: 1-16; Phil 2: 19-23

Skilled Craft: the gift that enables a believer to create, build, maintain, or repair items used within the church.
Ex 30: 1-6; Ex 31: 3-5; Ez 27; 4-11

Teaching: the gift that enables a believer to communicate a personal understanding of the Bible and faith in such a way that it becomes clear and understood by others.
1 Cor 12: 28; Mt 5: 1-12; Acts 18: 24-48

Wisdom: the gift that allows the believer to sort through opinions, facts and thoughts in order to determine what solution would be best for the individual believer or the community of believers.
1 Cor 2:6-13; Jas 3: 13-18; 2 Chr 1: 7-11

Writing: the gift that gives a believer the ability to express truth in a written form; a form that can edify, instruct and strengthen the community of believers.
1 Jn 2: 1-6, 12-14; 1 Tim 3: 14-15; Jude 3
