Examen Prayer Variations

The purpose of the Examen is to notice God's presence and his work within you, through you and around you. There are many variations; here are just a few. Try praying one of these for 5-10 minutes a day, every day. Then notice how much more aware you are of the action of the Holy Spirit as you go about your days.

Reimagining the Examen

Free app available for Android and Apple devices.

Two Questions Examen

- 1. Sit comfortably and take a few deep breaths. Breathe in God's unconditional love and when you breathe out, fill the space around you with his love.
- 2. Place your hand on your heart, aware of the presence of Jesus. Ask him to help you recall the moment today for which you are <u>most grateful</u>. Remember what was said and done in that moment that made it so special. Breathe in the gratitude you feel.
- 3. Ask God to bring to your heart the moment today for which you are <u>least grateful</u>. Remember what was said and done in that moment that made it so difficult. Sit with whatever you feel without trying to change or fix it in any way.
- 4. Give thanks to God for whatever you have experienced.
- 5. Journal about the experience.

Alternative Questions:

- When did I give and receive the most love today? When did I give and receive the least love today?
- When did I feel most alive today? When did I feel life draining out of me?
- When today did I have the greatest sense of belonging to myself, others, God and the universe? When did I have the least sense of belonging?
- What was today's high point? What was today's low point?

Paying Attention to Key Things

- 1. Begin by praying for the Spirit's guidance to become aware of what God wants you to notice as you review your day.
- 2. Ask yourself: What happened today that I do not want to forget or I can't forget?
- 3. What message was/is God trying to get through to me?
- 4. Given this how am I called to respond?
- 5. Close with a prayer of gratitude. Journal about the experience.

Traditional Examen

- 1. **Prayer for guidance and of gratitude** Begin with a simple prayer asking the Holy Spirit for inspiration and guidance as you review your day. Remember that all you have and all you are is a gift from God. Thank him.
- 2. **Practical Survey** Let your mind drift over the last 24 hours, without judging yourself, whether approval or disapproval. First, pay attention to and delight in only those moments of the day for which you are grateful. Then recall your inner moods and feelings, noting, if you can, what led to them, but again without self-judgment. The important thing is to let Christ show you where you have allowed God to work in you or through you and if you have resisted or refused. Thank God for the times when you did and ask forgiveness for the times you didn't. Here are some questions that may help you get started:
 - a. What moment am I most grateful for? What am I least grateful for?
 - b. What was best about today? What was most difficult?
 - c. What did I enjoy most? What am I unhappy about?
 - d. How did I experience or give love today? How did I experience the absence of love?
- 3. **Conversion** Usually there is one area of our hearts that God is calling to your attention, asking you to be more aware or perhaps change because it can mean a fuller life for you.
- 4. **Conclusion** Conclude with a short prayer, giving thanks for the day a prayer that also looks forward to the day to come, and asks for God's help.
- 5. **Journal** about the experience.

Praying a Review of the Day

Lord Jesus Christ, at the close of this day I come before you.

Center my heart deep within your own; fill me with a growing awareness of your love and a greater desire to serve you.

Lord Jesus, I thank you for the gifts of this day... (Pause to recall these)

Lord Jesus, through this day you have been calling me and inviting me in these ways... (Pause to recall these)

Lord Jesus, I ask for healing and forgiveness for those times today when I was less than faithful... (Pause to recall these)

Lord Jesus, I beg you to bring to reality these desires that you have placed within me... (Pause to recall these)

Lord Jesus, please be with me in the coming day with your gifts of... (Pause to name those places where you are likely to need his help.)

Lord Jesus, compassionate heart of God, as you disciple and in your Spirit, may my life ever more be given to the glory of God. Amen.
